



by 1899 and the result was overcrowding of the Reserve. With its key location in a developing city, this situation put the its key location in a developing city, this situation put the Mi/kmag in conflict with their neighbours who were not accustomed to the Native way of life. So began the King's Road Indian Reserve Court Case to remove the Mi/kmag from the land. In 1914, at the time of the King's Road Court Case, there were 27 homes and 27 individual families living on the Reserve.









